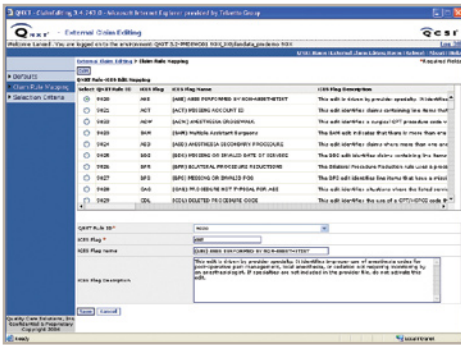
#### **Comprehensive Commercial and Medicare Editing for Professional and Facility Claims**

The Ingenix Claims Editing System automatically checks each claim for errors, omissions, and questionable coding relationships by testing the data against an expansive KnowledgeBase containing more than nine million government and industry rules, regulations, and policies governing health care claims. The system automatically detects coding errors related to unbundling, modifier appropriateness, mutually exclusive and incidental procedures, duplicate claims, and multiple surgical reductions and anesthesia processing to name a few.

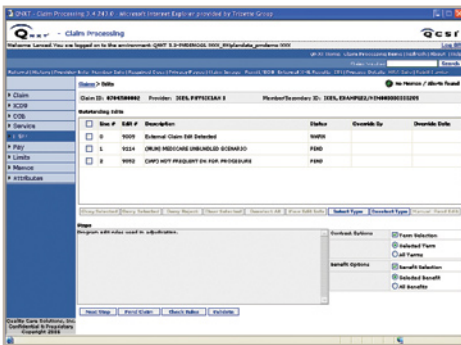
#### **Customized Rules Creation**

The Ingenix Claims Editing System features a unique rules engine that allows health plans to customize the software's editing logic to support user-defined rules and reimbursement policies. Users can enter, apply and turn off codes, modifiers and edits as necessary. All edits are applied using date-sensitive auditing to ensure that appropriate edits are applied based on the date the service was rendered. Users can also define the sequence in which rules are applied and can define the level of automation for denials, monitoring, and claims requiring review.

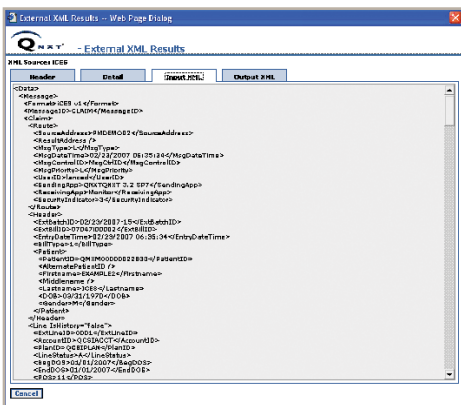
Ingenix Claims Editing System editing rules are displayed within the standard QNXT platform interface.

### Full Transparency and Disclosure

The Ingenix Claims Editing System offers transparency by providing sources for all edits as well as full visibility to the rule logic that is embedded in the system. In addition, disclosure statements are rooted within the Ingenix Claims Editing System to explain why a service is not reimbursable based on source or on a health plan's specific payment policy. Ingenix editing rules are built upon nationally recognized and accepted sources including AMA CPT guidelines, specialty society recommendations, the National Correct Coding Initiative and current medical practice standards. The Ingenix Claims Editing System makes these sources and disclosure statements visible to users to improve communication with providers and minimize the impact of potential inquiries and appeals.

### Seamless Integration with the QNXT Workflow

An adapter is now available to seamlessly integrate the Ingenix Claims Editing System into the QNXT workflow. The adapter supports online, batch, and web processing using existing QNXT exit services technology. The QNXT platform passes the member's paid claims history and current claim data, including ITS data, to the Ingenix system in XML format.

The QNXT system stores messages from the Ingenix Claims Editing System including original input data and line item detail for clinical editing results. One clinical edit type is stored in QNXT for each line item and all clinical edits for each line are stored in the Ingenix system to enable detailed auditing and data review.
